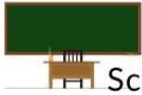

IMPORTANT UPDATES/CHANGES FOR 2019 - 2020 SCHOOL YEAR

The new school year will be soon upon us and we want to make sure everyone is aware of any changes that affect MDS families, as well as important reminders for everyone. The following changes and reminders are to help us provide a high quality education and for the safety of our students. Please read below to make sure you are up to date and in the loop!



SCHOOL START TIME

School for PreK - 8th will start at **8:00 a.m.**



BACKPACKS

NO Rolling Backpacks for any students.



ABSENCES

EXCUSED:

- ANY Absence due to a Dr's Appointment with a Dr's note.
- If a child is sick and the parent calls and notifies the school.
- After 3 days of being sick, student must be brought to school with a Dr's note.
- Death in the family.

UNEXCUSED: ANY other reason not stated above.



PRESCHOOL PICK UP

NON Rainy Days - Parents **MUST** wait outside by the Madonna Statue to pick up Preschoolers.

Rainy Days - Parents pick up students in the classroom.



UNIFORMS

TK - 5TH - No White Polo Shirts unless under a sweater, vest, or dress. Blue Uniform Pants (No Kahki)

6-8TH: Middle School Girls - All Navy Blue Skirts with New Uniform Vendor. NO acrylic nails or nail polish.

ALL GRADES: Shoes **MUST ONLY** contain Black, Navy, Grey or White colors. No other colors Allowed. All outer sweaters and jackets **MUST** be Uniform. ALL hair accessories **MUST** be in only Uniform Colors. No Scarfs allowed. Beenies and Gloves in **ONLY** school uniform colors. No Earrings for Boys. Girls are allowed small post earrings.

Uniforms from OLD and NEW Vendor are allowed.

NEW VENDOR will be Dennis Uniforms.



NEW TUITION PAYMENT SYSTEM

APPOINTMENTS

Please contact the office to schedule meetings with the Principal, Teachers, and Staff 24 hours in advance.



VIRTUS

ALL volunteers **NEED** to complete VIRTUS (including those who completed Shield the Vulnerable)



MEDICATIONS

ALL Medications must be brought to the office and the Diocesan Medical Form on file.



TARDIES

Students are considered **LATE** after 8:00 a.m. Parents **MUST** accompany students to the office for a LATE Slip after 8:10 a.m.

For EVERY 3 Tardies per student, 1 extra Service hour will be added.



UNIFORM VIOLATIONS

Students in Uniform Violation will be given a Violation write up. For every 3 uniform violations 1 extra service hour will be added.



STUDENT PICK UP

At the end of the day - **NO ONE** will be buzzed in unless you are picking up a Preschooler from Extension. Or if you need to pick your student up for a Drs. Appointment you **MUST** sign them out at the office. Students will be called out of class when you are in the office. Parents/Family will **NOT** be allowed to wait by the classes.

After school Pick Up Parents **MUST** also park and pick up child from teacher.



BEFORE SCHOOL EXTENSION

Morning Extension is from 7:00 a.m. - 8:00 a.m. Students will be released to class at 7:50 a.m. .



VOLUNTEER SERVICE HOURS - DONATION OF HOURS

All families may **ONLY** donate up to 5 service hours to another family per school year. All families may **ONLY** receive up to 5 donated service hours for the school year.



SCHOOL FUNDRAISING

Families will be required to participate in 2 Mandatory Fundraisers. The 2 fundraisers will be determined by the Principal and parents will be notified in advance.



LUNCHES

ALL Lunches **MUST** be turned into the school office.



VISITORS

ALL VISITORS for PreSchool - 8th Grade **MUST** sign in with the Front Office. **NO** Exceptions!
